GUIDELINES	<b>COMPOST CART:</b> No Plastic Bags. Use paper bags or compostable bags with one of these symbols:  OR 	1
	<b>WASTE CART:</b> No non-transparent or blue bags; use clear plastic only.	2
	Cart too heavy - Maximum 220 lbs.	3
	Contact IWMC for cart warranty repairs.	4
RECYCLABLES Clean & Dry	<b>BLUE BAG #1:</b> Recyclable paper & paper products.	5
	<b>BLUE BAG #2:</b> Milk cartons, <b>RECYCLABLE</b> plastics (symbols # 1 - 5), metal items (50% or more metal), extension cords, and container glass.	6
	<b>Cardboard</b> - Place flattened & bundled cardboard <u>next</u> to Blue Bags.	7
	<b>Electronic Material</b> - <b>FREE</b> drop-off at WWDC.	8
COMPOST	<b>Non-Recyclable Paper Products</b> (paper towel, napkins, paper bag, paper gift wrap, boxboard) are <b>COMPOST</b> .	9
	<b>Yard &amp; Garden Material an Food Scraps</b> (including shells and meat/fish bones) are <b>COMPOST</b> .	10
SPECIAL DISPOSAL	<b>NO ASHES</b> - Place in cardboard box <u>beside</u> cart.	11
	<b>NO NEEDLES/SYRINGES</b> - <i>Protect yourself &amp; others!</i> <b>FREE</b> container available at participating <b>PHARMACIES</b> .	12
	<b>NO HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS MATERIALS</b> (paint, cleaners, light bulbs, etc.) - <b>FREE</b> drop off at WWDC.	13
