With hunting season right around the corner, the handling of ammunition and other explosive items increases, and so does the risk of accidents.

## **STEPS for PROPER DISPOSAL by HOUSEHOLDERS:**

- Contact your local police department by phone during regular business hours;
- Provide a description of the items to be destroyed;
- Follow the directions for proper disposal provided by the Police Officer;
- **DO NOT DISPOSE** of items in any other manner.

**PLEASE! DO NOT BRING ITEMS OF AN EXPLOSIVE NATURE TO YOUR LOCAL POLICE STATION ... ALWAYS CALL FIRST!**
