

Household Hazardous Waste Technician

PERMANENT FULL-TIME POSITION Charlottetown

Based at IWMC's Charlottetown Household Hazardous Waste Depot, the position involves receiving, handling, classifying, documenting and shipping household hazardous waste (HHW) and materials requiring special disposal from customers. The incumbent is responsible for depot operation including opening/closing, customer service, traffic control, and maintenance duties such as shoveling, salting and keeping the depot tidy. The HHW Technician works outdoors for prolonged periods of time in varying weather conditions (rain, snow, sun, wind, etc.).

Hours of Work: Monday to Friday (8-4) and Saturday (7 – 2:15) for approximately 45 hours per week.

Qualifications: The successful applicant must have Grade 12 or equivalent, a valid driver's license, good verbal and written communication skills, the ability to work with minimal supervision, and a good understanding of Waste Watch sorting principles. He/she must be physically fit and able to lift and move heavy drums and equipment. Training in skidsteer or forklift operation is an asset as is the ability to communicate in French. ***Specialized training for this position will be provided.***
