

PROPER DISPOSAL OF...



RESIDENTIAL EXCESS MATERIALS

At certain times of the year, some households generate more wastes than the carts will hold. This is true for compostables during the growing season due to yard and garden maintenance and for all waste streams at annual holidays or large family celebrations.

PLEASE NOTE:

- A maximum of 2 additional containers or bags or small 'bulky' items (less than 4 feet in length) will be collected during regular collection if placed beside the appropriate cart.
- Excess containers, bags or items each must weigh less than 50 lbs.
- The maximum weight per cart is 220 lbs.

ITEMS NEVER COLLECTED

AT CURBSIDE:

- construction and demolition material
- material from businesses (including home-based businesses)
- appliances such as fridges, stoves, etc.
- hazardous material
- tires
- electronics



COMPOSTABLE MATERIAL:

- Excess compostables should be in **OPEN, RIGID CONTAINERS**. A container is the preferred option both environmentally and economically as it can be used over & over again.
- If a container is not possible, **PAPER YARD** and **GARDEN** bags should be used.

PLEASE NOTE: A restriction on the collection of YARD & GARDEN MATERIAL will be imposed for a period of approximately one month prior to SPRING & FALL CLEANUP.

THIS RESTRICTION DOES NOT APPLY TO REGULAR HOUSEHOLD COMPOSTABLES.

Please refer to your collection calendar for Spring and Fall effective dates.

WASTE MATERIAL:

- When cart is full, **OPEN, RIGID CONTAINERS** may be used.
- If a container is not possible, a **clear, transparent PLASTIC** bag may be used.
- Transparent blue and solid-coloured bags of any kind **ARE NOT PERMITTED** for waste material.
