IMPORTANT!!

- All material leaving your apartment
 MUST BE SORTED
- Keep outside sorting stations clean & tidy
- DO NOT put household hazardous waste (HHW) in outdoor containers

TENANT / LANDLORD FAQ's (Frequently Asked Questions)

Is Waste Watch Mandatory?

Yes, sorting is mandatory for all tenants. **There are no exceptions!**

Who Pays for Waste Watch?

The landlord pays for Waste Watch through property taxes, which in turn is charged to tenants through monthly rental fees. Carts or blue bags with mixed waste will be rejected. The landlord must pay extra for disposal, which can lead to rent increases or eviction. **Doing your part will help keep costs in line.**
