PREFERRED METHOD FOR PAPER BAGS

PAPER BAGS & CORRUGATED CARDBOARD
(Collapsed & bundled)

LARGE METAL ITEMS

- ✓ bundle multiple items (tent poles, curtain rods, etc.)
- ✓ less than 4 feet & 50 lb.
- ✓ dismantle large items
- ✗ no propane cylinders, tanks or items containing Freon

PLACE THE ITEMS LISTED ABOVE BESIDE YOUR BLUE BAGS

BLUE BAG #1

USE BLUE TRANSPARENT BAGS ONLY!

Please ensure blue bags are tied securely

Recyclables must be clean and dry

BLUE BAG #2

Plastics with symbols:

METAL

COMPOST

NO BAG IS BEST!

TIP: USE EMPTY BOXBOARD TO GATHER KITCHEN SCRAPS

If bags are necessary:

- ✓ paper bags are preferred
- ✓ film compostable bags must be identified by:

BPI OR **BPI** COMPOSTABLE IN INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES

OR

COMPOSTABLE www.compostable.info

✗ Do not use plastic bags

NO Metal
NO Glass
IN COMPOST CART

WASTE

NO BAG IS BEST!

If bags are necessary:

- ✓ use clear, transparent bags
- ✗ No blue bags
- ✗ No solid-coloured bags
- ✗ No paper bags

DO NOT USE solid-coloured bags FOR WASTE MATERIAL

EXCESS MATERIALS: When your cart is full, drivers will accept up to **TWO** open rigid containers, extra bags, or bulky items placed **BESIDE** the appropriate cart. If bags are used, paper yard & garden bags must be used for **COMPOST**, and clear, transparent plastic bags for **WASTE**. **All excess items, including additional bags & containers placed beside carts must be within 50 lb & 4 ft.**

**NEVER COLLECTED IN CARTS, BLUE BAGS,
DUMPSTERS OR DURING SPRING/FALL CLEANUP!!**
