# SPRING CLEANUP

## Mon., MAY 3.... COMPOST Mon., MAY 10... WASTE Mon., MAY 17... COMPOST

Collection trucks will stop <u>once</u> at each residence for each weekly category. Please have sorted material curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the date indicated:

#### **GUIDELINES:**

- Each item must be less than 50 lb. and 4 ft. Multiple items (such as branches) must be bundled.
- Categories <u>MUST BE</u> kept separate at curbside.
- No plastic bags for yard & garden material.

DRIVERS HAVE THE ENTIRE WEEK TO COLLECT YOUR MATERIAL. If you have not received pickup by the Saturday of each respective cleanup week, you must report the miss to Customer Service at 1-888-280-8111 no later than Tuesday of the following week.

#### **ACCEPTABLE CONTAINERS:**

- COMPOSTABLES: Grass, leaves, and other loose compostables must be placed in open, rigid containers, or in paper bags.
- WASTE: Waste items must be placed in open, rigid containers or in clear, transparent bags.
   Bulk items (within guidelines) may be placed curbside directly.





#### ITEMS THAT ARE NEVER COLLECTED CURBSIDE:

The following items WILL NOT be collected curbside, but can be taken to a Waste Watch Drop-Off Center at any time of the year:

#### NO CHARGE FOR THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- household hazardous waste (HHW) \*
- appliances containing ozone depleting substances
- household furniture larger than 4 ft. and/or
  50 lb. such as sofas, mattresses, etc.
- large appliances (such as stoves, fridges, etc.)
- propane tanks (30 lb. & smaller)
- tires (off rims)
- electronic materials



### A DISPOSAL FEE MAY APPLY FOR THESE ITEMS:

- items that do not meet above guidelines or not contained properly
- items from businesses (including hobby farms)
- construction, demolition and renovation material
- metals (part of blue bag program)
