

RESIDENTIAL

Each year in May and November, IWMC provides a residential cleanup service. The cleanup allows households to dispose of **excess** waste material or yard debris.

## **YARD DEBRIS**

Yard debris materials are collected **twice** during each cleanup month. Please ensure yard debris materials are placed curbside by 7:00 A.M. on Monday of the specified yard debris week.

## WASTE

Starting in November 2024, waste materials will be collected on your regular waste collection (black cart) days during each cleanup month. Please ensure waste items are placed next to your waste cart by 7:00 A.M. on your normal collection day (see collection calendar for schedule).

# **CLEANUP GUIDELINES:**

- Each item should not exceed a length of four (4) feet for any dimension
- Each item should not exceed fifty (50) lbs (22 kg) •
- Larger items can be cut/folded to meet these guidelines ٠
- Multiple items must be bundled (when practical), but the bundle must still meet the guidelines
- Leaves can be in rigid containers or paper bags •
- Waste can be in waste carts, rigid containers, or clear plastic bags

# ACCEPTABLE CONTAINERS:

**YARD DEBRIS:** Grass, leaves, and other loose compostables must be placed in open and rigid containers or in paper bags. Please do not use cardboard boxes.

### NOTE: YARD DEBRIS IN PLASTIC BAGS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED!

**WASTE:** Waste items must be placed in rigid containers, or in clear and transparent plastic bags. Bulk items (within guidelines) may be placed curbside directly.

#### Q: What's an acceptable rigid container?

A: Two examples of acceptable rigid containers are Rubbermaid bins and fish pans or tubs.



## ITEMS THAT ARE NEVER COLLECTED FOR CLEANUP:

The following items **WILL NOT** be collected during cleanup or during weekly curbside collection, but they can be taken to a Waste Watch Drop-Off Center at any time of the year.

#### NO CHARGE FOR THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- Household hazardous waste (HHW)
- Appliances containing freon
- Large household furniture such as sofas, mattresses, box springs, etc.
- Large appliances such as stoves, fridges, etc.
- Propane tanks (30 lb. or less)
- Tires (off rims)
- Electronic material

#### A DISPOSAL FEE MAY APPLY FOR THESE ITEMS:

- Items from businesses (including hobby farms)
- Items that do not meet above guidelines or are not contained properly
- Construction, demolition, and renovation material (indoor and outdoor projects)
- Metals (not part of Blue Bag collection)
