

ACCEPTABLE BAGS for WASTE WATCH

RECYCLABLES:

BLUE Transparent Plastic Bags ONLY!



COMPOSTABLES: Household & Kitchen Material



Place loose material directly into your kitchen mini bin, then empty into the compost cart.



Next best is boxboard boxes. Reuse these to gather food scraps.



If using a bag, a paper bag is the recommended choice.

NO BAG IS BEST!!

While not preferred, non paper compostable 'film' bags may be used but only if they have one of the following certification logos :



COMPOSTABLE IN INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES

OR



COMPOSTABLES: Excess and Yard & Garden Material



PLEASE!! Make sure Compost Cart is full before using excess containers!



Use rigid containers (like an old garbage can) if your cart is full.



If a bag is necessary, use a paper yard & garden bag.

NOTE: Compostable 'film' bags (see above logos) should not be used. These bags are designed to biodegrade and, in warm & moist conditions, may begin to break down prior to your collection day.

NO BAG IS BEST!!

WASTE: Household Material

Consider using a small container in your home for waste items and simply empty material into your waste cart.



Clear transparent bags may be used.



Excess Waste

Use rigid containers or clear transparent plastic bags if your cart is full.

Bulky items (within guidelines) can be placed directly beside the cart.



NO BAG IS BEST!!

DO NOT USE BLUE BAGS OR PAPER BAGS FOR WASTE!

SOLID COLOURED BAGS ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE!!
